

Farm Household Allowance

A payment for farming families in financial hardship.

To get this you must:

- be a farmer or partner of a farmer
- meet the income and assets test limits
- meet mutual obligation requirements.

A farmer must contribute significant labour and capital to a farm.

You need to meet eligibility requirements to get Farm Household Allowance.

How much you can get ^[3]

The amount of Farm Household Allowance you can get depends on your circumstances.

A Farm Household Case Officer will contact you when you start getting Farm Household Allowance. They'll guide and support you while you're on this payment.
