

Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment - South Australia

Support if you live in South Australia and can't earn an income because you must self-isolate or quarantine, or are caring for someone with COVID-19.

Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment is a lump sum payment to help you during the 14 days you need to self-isolate, quarantine or care for someone. If you need longer term help, check to see what other payments you may be eligible to get by using our [payment guide](#) ^[1].

The Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment is for people living in South Australia who can't earn an income because they must self-isolate, quarantine or care for someone who has COVID-19.

You must be directed to self-isolate or quarantine by a health official. This includes a person employed by:

- SA Health
- a state or regional department of health.

Who can get it ^[3]

You need to meet eligibility requirements to get the Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment - South Australia.

Who can't get it ^[4]

Not everyone who lives in South Australia can get the Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment.

How much you can get ^[5]

If you're eligible we'll pay you \$1,500 for each 14 day period you've been told to self-isolate or quarantine ,or are caring for someone who has COVID-19.
