



COVID-19 Consumer Travel Support Program

14 December 2020

Summary

The COVID-19 Consumer Travel Support Program is a one off payment, announced by the Australian Government on 1 December 2020, which recognises that travel agents are operating in an exceptional set of circumstances during the COVID-19 pandemic, where most are having to refund last year's income while continuing to work with no additional income. This assistance will help keep travel agents afloat at a time when they continue to hold travel credits for consumers.

Under the \$128 million scheme, eligible travel agents and tour arranging service businesses, will be able to apply for a one-off taxable payment. Payments will be scaled based on the turnover of the business, with a minimum payment of \$1,500 for a business with a turnover of \$50,000 up to a maximum payment of \$100,000 for a business with a turnover of \$20 million.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a payment, a business will need to meet the following requirements:

- Operating a business as either a travel agent or tour arrangement service provider prior to the announcement of the closure of international borders by the Prime Minister on 19 March 2020,
- Have had an annual turnover starting from \$50,000 up to a maximum of \$20 million for the 2019 calendar year,
- Be in receipt of the extension of the JobKeeper payment which is available for eligible businesses from 28 September 2020 to 28 March 2021.

Timing

Eligible businesses will be able to apply for a claim under the COVID-19 Consumer Travel Support Program from 14 December 2020. Applications will be accepted until midnight (AEDT) 13 March 2021 or until funds are exhausted.
