## How does it work?

You can register to advertise jobs to qualified workers on the online jobs platform.

Jobs should be:

- ideally for at least three months, but short-term seasonal roles may also be advertised
- paid at the award rate, or the site rate, whichever is higher.

Through the online jobs platform you can:

- post jobs
- conduct initial screening
- select from the full list of applicants or receive a short list.

## How do I get started?

Complete the [registration form](#) – with contact and business details.

Once your registration has been processed:

1. We will contact you to discuss opportunities available and help set up your account.
2. You can create your company profile with logo, overview and links to your website.
3. You can then start posting jobs on the online platform.
